As soon as we have the finalized dates, venues and other info from the meet organizers, we will let you know more about them.

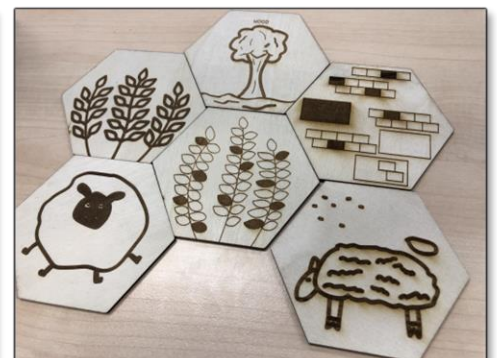
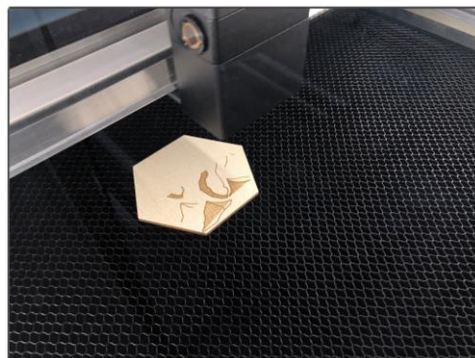
If you are interested in cross-country running, please complete a permission form and return it without delay. If you are doing multiple activities, an alternate way of training is a possibility.

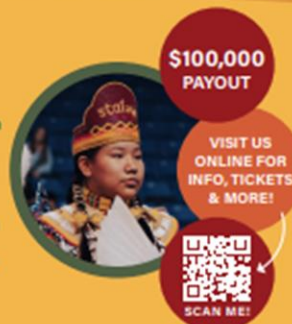
