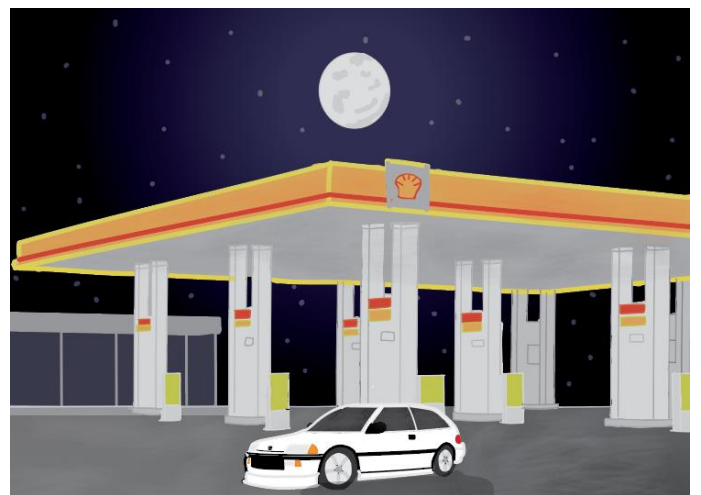


All items needing to be found will be displayed in the main foyer beginning on Monday afternoon until Wednesday. After that time, all remaining items will be donated to a local charity.
